CONTEST INFORMATION

Eligible: Living in San Diego County, Female senior in High School, who has been accepted and signed a letter of intent to attend a College or University.

Application Deadline: Interested students must submit an essay, application, proof of college acceptance and/or attendance, photograph suitable for publication and liability release form to their La Mesa/El Cajon AAUW CA Branch by midnight March 31, 2025

Essay: 500-1000 words expressing "Why are you applying for this scholarship", based on the purpose of the scholarship.

Judging: Judges shall use the official ballot and score each 500 - 1000 word essay accordingly. Content should include Introduction, Organization and Conclusion.

Award and Presentation: The scholarship recipient will be asked to attend the May La Mesa/El Cajon Monthly meeting to accept their scholarship and give a short overview of their future interests (approximately 5 minutes).

Prizes: Each awardee will receive between \$500.00 - \$1,000.00 award this will be determined by the scholarship committee.
